WHAT IS PLAGIARISM?



According to the Merriam-Webster dictionary, "to steal and pass off (the ideas or words of another) as one's own: use (another's production) without crediting the source."

CITE YOUR SOURCE

Add source information such as the author, title, and published date.




USE QUOTES

Use quotation marks to cite text that is not your own.

PARAPHRASE

Re-write the text without changing the author's original meaning. Be careful with this one- you don't want to plagiarize someone's work accidentally!



YOUR OWN PERSPECTIVE

Create your own unique point of view. Remember, you still must cite your source to avoid plagiarism.



USE A CHECKER TOOL

A plagiarizing checking tool can scan your text to see if you have plagiarized.
