- Access will be granted to applicants who comply with all of the requirements, according to availability.
- Electronic devices will be kept at the Embassy entrance.

- Application form DS-11 or DS-82 available at the waiting room **or** you can complete it and print it at <https://eforms.state.gov/>
- 2"x2" photo
- Travel itinerary within 5 business days
- Consular service fee

Requirements

LOST OR STOLEN PASSPORT

- Form DS-11
- Form DS-64 (lost/stolen report)
- Current ID (if you have one)
- USD \$165

EXPIRED PASSPORT

Present previous passport

For adults (10-year validity):

- If expired less than 5 years ago: form DS-82
- USD \$130

- If expired more than 5 years ago: form DS-11
- USD \$165

For minors under 16:

- Form DS-11
- Birth certificate
- USD \$135
- Both parents must accompany child, or present original and notarized DS-3053 consent form from the absent parent.

For minors over 16:

- Form DS-11
- USD \$165

For all cases:

Travel itinerary and 2"x2" white background photo taken in the last 6 months.

Payment methods:

Colombian pesos or U.S. dollars in cash, U.S. credit card or U.S. debit card. The card must be in the name of the person who will pay the passport fee.

Companions:

Only for minors and persons who require assistance.
